North Allerdale Development Trust (NADT) In partnership with World Film Collective (WFC) will deliver the UK pilot of WFC's education-to-earning model , training young people not in education, training or employment to be digital filmmakers and social media marketers with the business acumen to earn an income from these skills.

We are looking to recruit the following positions:

1 x Project Manager – Salary up to £24,000 pro rata dependant on experience (6 month fulltime fixed term contract)

The Project Manager will co-ordinate programmes to train young people to make films on cell phones, edit and distribute through social media. Previous experience in either the film/television industry OR on creative projects with Youth is essential. The role will involve the management of Tutors, management of contracts, build and maintain relationships with delivery partners, accurate monitoring and evaluation and regular reporting, therefore previous experience of management of resources and budgets is required. A key role will be to develop relationships with key stakeholders, in particular in the media and communications industries, ensuring follow-through for the students and helping to build the WFC brand.

2 x Tutors – Salary £19,860 to £21,960 pro rata dependant on experience (6 month fulltime fixed term contract)

Tutors will be filmmaking professionals able to teach filmmaking, digital marketing, distribution and production to young marginalised people giving them a voice through film. We require proficient filmmakers, and ideally have experience of facilitating work with young people. A good working knowledge of Sony Vegas, Lightworks and Final Cut Pro editing software is essential along with experience of crowd-funding through Kickstarter and of online marketing and digital distribution. Successful applicants will be required to attend a 2-day training session in the methodology and techniques used in the training programme.
